A word from the principal and welcome to the seventh week of term 3

A reminder that our 15 Mile Creek camp is in the 1st week of term 4. It is a 4 day camp, beginning Monday, October 7th to Thursday, October 10th at Greta, near Wangaratta. Please fill out the consent form, the medical information form, asthma update form (if required), the action plan for anaphylactic/allergic reactions (if required). These forms will need to be completed and returned to school by <a href="mailto:next">next</a> Monday, September 2nd. The cost of the camp is \$50 per child for the 4 days. The cost of this camp has been heavily subsidized to make it affordable for all families.

Our trip to the National Gallery of Victoria, Melbourne is this Thursday, August 29th. The bus will leave the school at 7.30am sharp. The students will need to be at school no later than 7.15am. Lunch, snacks and 2 bottles of water will be necessary for this trip. We anticipate being back at school at approximately 6pm. All students must be wearing their full school uniform.

As our weather begins to warm up, it is important that every student has a water bottle on their table during the school day. Please make sure that your child comes to school with a fresh bottle of water because it helps to hydrate the brain, therefore improving concentration.


